

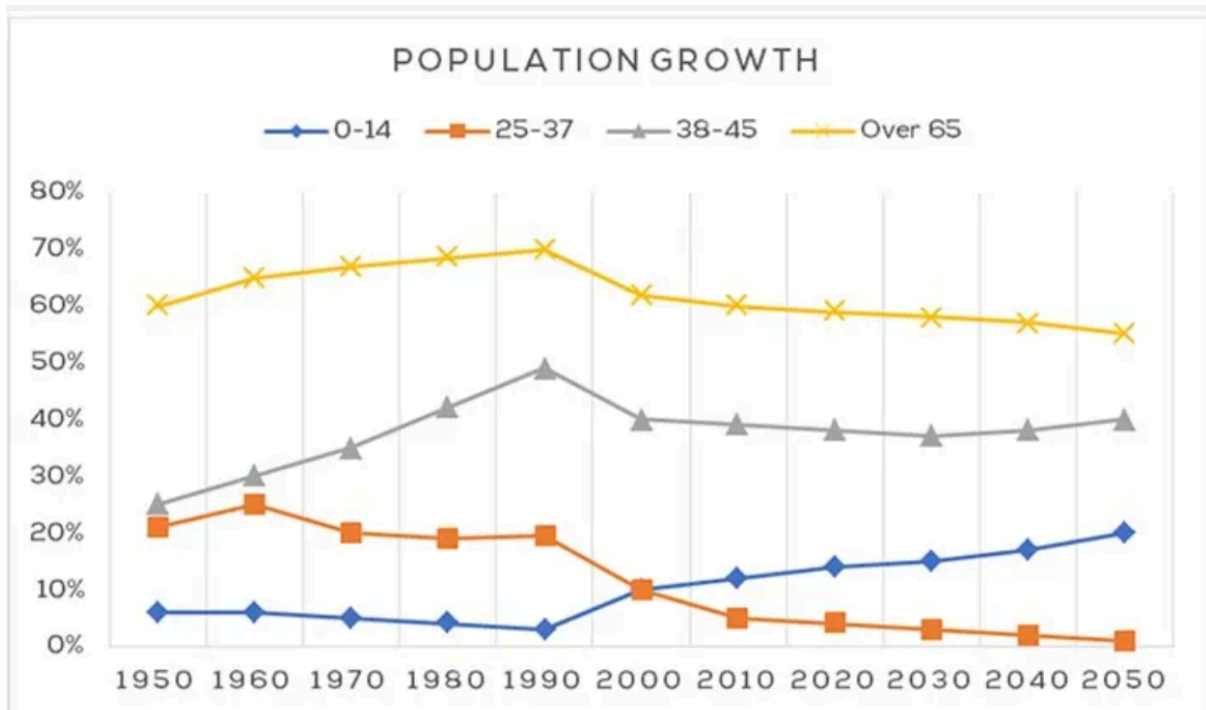


BÀI MẪU IELTS WRITING TASK 1

1. Đề bài:

The line graph shows the percentage of New Zealand population from 1950 to 2050.

Summarize the information by selecting and reporting the main features and make comparisons where relevant.



Bài mẫu tham khảo:

The given line graph gives information about the proportion of inhabitants of New Zealand of different age groups, over the period of 100 years, from 1950 to 2050.

From an overview, it is clearly seen that while the proportions of people in the 0-14 and 15-34 age groups are expected to decrease, the opposite is true for the rest categories. Also the year 1990 witnessed the highest.

In a more detailed analysis, between 1950 and 1990, the percentage of people aged 15-24 ascended substantially, reaching a peak of 45%. followed by a gradual descent of approximately 5%. After that, that group experienced a noticeable decline before being expected to fall gently by around 5% from 2030 to 2050. In terms of children under 14, the figure for this group registered a downward trend from 1950 to 2010 and is predicted to drop slightly from 2030 to 2050.

A steady increase in the proportion of inhabitants aged 35 to 64 was witnessed in a period of 80 years (1950-2010) and is anticipated to ascend significantly by nearly 10% (2030-2050). Moving on to specific data of the elderly aged 65 and above, after a period of stability in the first 4 decades, it fluctuated from 1990 to 2020. By 2050, it is anticipated that one in every five New Zealanders will fall under this age group.

2. Đề bài

Task 1 Table

The table shows the Proportions of Pupils Attending Four Secondary School Types Between 2000 and 2009.

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features and make comparisons where relevant.

Secondary School Attendance

	2000	2005	2009
Specialist Schools	12%	11%	10%
Grammar Schools	24%	19%	12%
Voluntary-controlled Schools	52%	38%	20%
Community Schools	12%	32%	58%

The table illustrates the percentage of school children attending four different types of secondary school from 2000 to 2009. It is evident that whereas the community schools experienced a marked increase in the proportion of those attending their institutions over the period, the others saw a corresponding decline.

To begin, the percentage of pupils in voluntary-controlled schools fell from just over half to only 20% or one fifth from 2000 to 2009. Similarly, the relative number of children in grammar schools - just under one quarter - dropped by half in the same period. As for the specialist schools, the relatively small percentage of pupils attending this type of school (12%) also fell, although not significantly.

However, while the other three types of school declined in importance, the opposite was true in the case of community schools. In fact, whereas only a small minority of 12% were educated in these schools in 2000, this figure increased to well over half of all pupils during the following nine years.

3. Đề bài

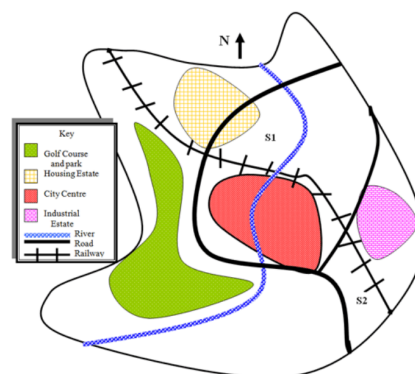

Below is a map of the city of Brandfield. City planners have decided to build a new shopping mall for the area, and two sites, S1 and S2 have been proposed.

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features and make comparisons where relevant.

The map illustrates plans for two possible sites for a shopping mall in the city of Brandfield. It can be seen that the two sites under consideration are in the north and the south east of the town.

The first possible site for the shopping mall, S1, is just north of the city center, above the railway line, which runs from the south east of the city to the north west. If it is built here, it will be next to a large housing estate, thus providing easy access for those living on the estate and in the city center. It will also be next to the river that runs through the town.

The site in the south east, S2, is again just by the railway line and fairly close to the city center, but it is near to an industrial estate rather than housing.

There is a main road that runs through the city and is close to both sites, thus providing good road access to either location. A large golf course and park in the west of the town prevents this area from being available as a site.
